

## Serenbe Bed & Breakfast

**S**erenbe: the combination of 'serenity' and 'be'; also, fittingly, the name of this peaceful bed and breakfast center stationed on 800 acres of rolling countryside. There are more than just farm animals who flock to the country farm and village locale, Founder Steve Nygren attests. A restored 1930s horse barn is now known as the Guest House, and it merges simple pleasures — antiques, folk art and a private porch overlooking a vegetable garden — with



today's more luxurious amenities, namely satellite TV, a Jacuzzi and direct pool access. Visitors may also choose to stay in one of the guest cottages, some of which include two-person air whirlpool baths, wet bars and fireplaces and which offer views of the lake. Finally, the Lake House (also overlooking the lake) is ideal for relaxing and watching farm animals from its large screen porch.

If city living has removed you from the more natural features of the earth, a visit to Serenbe can quickly get you back in touch

with your senses. Serenbe's turn-of-the-century buildings, surrounded by flower and vegetable gardens, are situated within the Chattahoochee Hill Country, some 40,000 acres of farmland, mature forests and miles of tributaries and rivers. At the same time, though, this bed and breakfast center provides the comforts and luxurious amenities of the present day. 0
